DABA DABA quickly took command, steadily increased his lead and was kept to steady urging. A FLEET SPIRIT rated early in the middle of the pack for three furlongs, advanced inside to stalk the pace, couldn't catch the winner but was clearly second best. CONGRATULATOR raced three-wide on both turns and had no rally. ANDY L bumped at the start, trailed into the backstretch, fanned three-wide into the stretch and had no rally. TRACK MAGNET pressed the pace three-wide on the first turn and weakened. LOCKED OUT bumped at the start and was outrun. AMBRAW went three-to-five wide on the first turn and was through early. LIGHTNING N HAIL was slow early, rushed four-wide on the first turn and was done after a half.
