IT'S ME MOM was away a step slow then quickly rushed inside to set the pace, was just off the inside off the turn, lost the lead nearing mid-stretch, responded late to right hand urging and determinedly came back to get up in the final stride while in tight through the final seventy yards. NICOLE H raced in close contention two wide into the turn, took command in mid-stretch and edged clear one-sixteenth out from the wire, couldn't withstand the winner late then just missed. KARMAGEDDON was off step slow, saved ground along the turn, had late energy through the stretch run and gained a share. D'WILD RIDE chased two wide along the turn, gained ground into upper stretch, altered course near the sixteenth marker and was gaining. WINNING IMAGE forced the pace early, was three wide onto the turn, faded into upper stretch and continued evenly late. D'CATS MEOW chased from the outside to the turn, was three wide leaving the turn but had no stretch bid. SASSY CITY was off slow then hustled inside into contention, faded into the lane and tired. LOVE THAT DANCE, bobbled slightly at break, chased three wide into the turn, had no response on the turn and tired. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run concerning the top two finishers.
