HOWARD THE AVIATOR dueled outside on the first turn, took command entering the backstretch, responded gamely when challenged in the upper stretch and prevailed under steady urging. IRON POST was well placed and finished well. JOE DENUCCI raced in the middle of the pack, came four-wide and finished well. SUPERLOOK raced in the middle of the pack and had a mild rally. COMMERSANT pressed the pace on the outside and weakened in the upper stretch. SMART FARDA dueled on the inside into the backstretch, pressed the pace to the stretch and weakened. MARSHALL raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. EVENFOREVER raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. TRULY SMART had speed for a half and tired. CRESCENT'S MON was no threat. A. V. JORDAN trailed.
