MRS. BEAN quickly sprinted clear, set the pace under stout restraint, steadily increased her lead without urging and won as the rider pleased. MISS GLORY was well placed for a half, came three-wide into the stretch, couldn't stay with the winner but was clearly second best. PUSH KAISER pressed the pace to the stretch and tired. A P PURE was no threat. NORTHEAST PRINCESS was through early. DESERT'S DOUBLE trailed.
