Footnotes

EL TIBURON moved in entering the turn outside a rival, repulsed a bid into the lane then steadily drove clear. NORTHERN BAYOU up close three wide, made a two wide bid leaving the turn, couldn't get to the winner but stayed on well. PUT HIM BACK in close contention three wide, couldn't keep pace and tired. MILL POINT inside into turn, three wide leaving turn, no impact. HIGH PROTOCOL was a bit slow from the gate then soon hustled inside, checked in tight on the rail into the turn then gave way. LOOSE GOOSE was outrun two wide, had nothing to offer into the stretch, tired. HERE COMES CODY awkwardly away from the gate, brief speed two wide, empty.
