OXFORD STREET duled early, pressed the pace on the backstretch and into the second turn, gained a short lead near the quarter pole, drew off and increased his lead under mild urging. MR. ROESSINK pressed the pace, fanned four-wide into the stretch and finished well. TECHNICAL EXPRESS saved ground in the middle of the pack and had no rally. RIO BONITA trailed early, remained outrun to the stretch and passed tiring rivals. BO BADGER bumped after the start, went five-wide on the first turn, fanned six-wide into the stretch and had no rally. CARISTO bumped after the start, fanned 3-to-5-wide on the first turn, angled inside but had no rally. DABA DABA set a pressured pace for five furlongs and tired. SILVER ENDURANCE went four-wide on the first turn, angled in to press the early pace and gave way into the stretch. LUCKY TRADER was through early.
