MANGROVE POND pressed the pace on the inside to the stretch, slipped through a narrow opening in the upper stretch to challenge for the lead approaching the furlong pole and drew off under intermittent urging. MY VALENTINO was slow early, rushed between horses to gain command near the half-mile, dueled into midstretch and tired. THE LANGER settled in stride under a rating hold, saved ground advancing into the stretch, angled out between horses and finished well. MYSTIC ERA had only brief speed. APPEALING YANKEE stumbled badly at the start, rushed to press the pace on the outside into the upper stretch and tired. GRAND COMMANDER was well placed for a quarter and gave way. LET IT BE HARDYBOY showed nothing. BLUESY CAT was never a factor.
