Footnotes

BORACAY WONDER dueled between horses to the second turn, quickly took command and steadily increased his lead on his own courage. BUCKS WINK was slow early, was far back for six furlongs, saved ground rallying into the stretch and finished well. COVE STAR was well placed to the second turn and tired. BROKEN SOUND was well placed into the backstretch, split rivals advancing to the half-mile pole, was blocked attempting to slip through on the inside into the second turn, split rivals rallying to the quarter pole, bolted badly into the stretch and bore out badly through the last furlong. HOLIDAY BOY dueled for the lead on the inside into the second turn and tired. CRAFTY PEACE dueled three or four-wide to the second turn and tired. STORMY SUCCESS was slow early and no threat. CHILLIN DYLAN went three-wide on the first turn and five-wide into the second turn and tired.
