T. V. SECRETARY battled to the turn from the rail, steadily edged away then was kept to steady urging. PREMIER PROMISE pressed the winner while two wide, chased that one home then continued willingly for the place. TRANQUILITY BASE in contention three wide, loomed in upper stretch and gradually weakened thereafter. STOPYOURTWINING off slowest, was taken outside rivals along the backstretch, chased from the four path and went evenly. TEA N TODDY forwardly placed from the rail, had nothing left in the stretch and weakened. BUT WHAT HYACINTH chased in the two path, gave way and tired. RED TRIBUTE never too far back, three wide around turn and tired.
