HOW CONVENIENT was outrun early, rallied three-wide on the turn, gained command a furlong out under strong urging and was kept to brisk urging. GRADY stalked the pace to the stretch, couldn't catch the winner but had a mild rally. INDEFINABLE HUMOR dueled, drew off on the turn, dueled inside the winner into the final furlong and weakened. NEWTON CRESCENT raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. GALAXY KAT dueled inside early, pressed the pace into the stretch and tired. SILK SPINNER had no excuse. COMMERSANT stumbled at the start and was outrun. CLASSIC SPEED stumbled at the start, rushed to press the pace for a half and tired in the upper stretch. MARSHALL trailed.
