ROBIN DIAMOND pressed the pace for six furlongs, challenged for the lead on the second turn, fought furiously through the stretch and prevailed under vigorous urging. PINE MOUNTAIN dueled for the lead throughout and just missed in a courageous effort. TURKO STAR was slow early, rallied five-wide on the second turn but failed to sustain his bid. CONCERT DELL was well placed and gave way. LITTLE ROCK LESNER went four-wide in the middle of the pack and gave way on the second turn. UNCLE MORDECAI went five-wide in the middle of the turn and gave way on the second turn. OMEGA SUPREME dueled on the outside to the second turn and was used up. MOVES LIKE JAGGER was outrun. JUST ASK JOHN dueled four-wide on the first turn and gave way on the second turn. ROSEMARY'S GAEL was well placed to the second turn and gave way.
