FUNKY COUNTRY dueled for the lead on the inside, drew off in the upper stretch, held a clear lead in midstretch and was all out to last. FRIENDS RULE was unhurried early, rallied five-wide into the stretch and finished furiously to just miss. MISFIT MANNY pressed the pace to the stretch, bid into the final furlong and finished well. COMMERSANT was well placed on the inside, rallied into the stretch, bid for the lead in the upper stretch and hung. SOLDIER FIELD was outrun and passed tiring rivals. BEAUREAL was well placed and had no rally. A. V. JORDAN was outrun. JOE DENUCCI had no speed. ROCKSTAR COWBOY dueled on the outside into the stretch and gave way. BIG MAHOGANY dueled three-wide for three furlongs and gave way. SUPERLOOK raced four-wide in the middle of the pack for three furlongs, gave way and was pulled up in the upper stretch.
