Footnotes

HALIC was rated within easy striking while out from the rail, moved two wide to command just after a half then tired while kept to urging. SUNLIT RIDGE was unhurried early, made a run along the rail around the turn then flattened out in the stretch. VALID MISS CHAIN was slow early, bore out badly on the turn while moving and gained to the end. GUESS broke slowly then was slow to settle, rallied three wide around the turn and gained late. SKIP FASHION cleared shortly after the break, stayed close to the inside, bore out nearing the stretch and stopped. DR. DESAI made a run four wide around the turn then stopped in the stretch. RHUBARB RED showed speed three wide then stopped. UPPERMOST INMYMIND stopped. REIGN ROSE was far back.
