Footnotes

BEIJING HOUSE settled back from duel, three wide move far turn, drove clear. TUCKLINO three wide into first turn, never far back, bid on the rail then held the place. PREACHER BUCK five wide into first turn, three wide along far turn, bid, tired. GLORIOUS SUNRISE four wide into first turn, carried out bid into lane, tired. FREIGHTER six wide into first turn, five wide into far bend, tired. KING MONGO rank, checked inside along first turn, take wide, tired. LUCRATIVE DEAL in contention three wide, no response far turn, eased over wire well distanced. SPECIAL AL hustled inside early to dispute pace, drifted into lane, eased and pulled up at the sixteenth marker.
