HIGH ON LUCK moved up the inside, slipped inside the leaders approaching the eighth pole and drew off through the final furlong. LADY IRENE moved up the inside, angled out into the stretch, proved no match for the winner and finished second best. BRASSY SHIRLEY up close and outside, moved three wide around the turn and weakened deep stretch. BOB'S VALENTINE assumed a short advantage, set the early pace and gave way when challenged. SHOUT advanced outside, wide around turn. BOX CUTTER chased off rail, tired into deep stretch. SKIP'S TRICK stalked early pacesetter, weakened into deep stretch.
