FARMA'S MARKET chased off the rail, made a run leaving the far turn, steadily gained ground into the lane and drove clear. LUCKY FOLLY was hustled to command, set the early pace, proved no match for the winner and finished second best. TORRANTULA wide into first turn, stalked pacesetter, weakened deep stretch. HUCKSTER'S GIRL trailed early, advanced outside, moved closer stretch, weakened. WINLOC'S MICKEY moved up the inside, angled out far turn, weakened stretch. APPLIED ECONOMICS saved ground, angled wide around far turn, tired stretch. WINLOCS SISTERKORA chased off rail, tired into stretch. DUE NATION was never a factor. FINEST COLLECTION wide first turn, wide far turn, never a factor.
