Footnotes

MISS CHIEF WOODY, well placed on the rail into the turn, swung out leaving the turn to be outside the leaders then wore down the runner up inside the final sixteenth. MEXICAN CONNECTION dueled two wide early, was clear on the rail to the sixteenth marker then yielded while easily best of the rest. WINLOCS LEAP YEAR was outrun early, came wide off the turn then continued evenly through the stretch for the show. BRIANNA DES PINS, never too far back, was four wide into the stretch and weakened. BENNETT OF BOLOGNA chased the leaders, made a two wide bid off the turn and weakened. FINAL RARE led in the early stages, battled from the inside, gave way leaving the turn and tired in the final furlong.
