DENIM WILDCAT assumed command, set the pace along the the inside, responded to a challenge leaving the turn, edged clear into the stretch and was kept to the task. CONFIDENT HEART advanced outside, went after the pacesetter around the far turn with her bid and weakened in the drive. PROCYON moved up inside, angled out stretch, made a late run, too late. ALL ABOUT SPEED advanced outside, three wide far turn, weakened into deep stretch. JEWEL ALARM chased outside, moved to rail backstretch, tired into stretch. WHISPERING BELLS advanced outside, wide around far turn. OVERTIMEANGIE BABY broke slow, wide first turn, tired. WINLOCS SUMMERWIND broke slow, wide first turn, tired. An objection by the rider of JEWEL ALARM against the winner for alleged interference into the far turn was not allowed.
