RUBIES AND JADE wide into the first turn, advanced outside, steadily gained ground into the lane and was up in time, driving. SUNNY WITCH moved to the rail around the far turn, made a late run into deep stretch, too late. WINLOC'S MICKEY wide into the first turn, made a run four wide around the far turn with her bid, but was not good enough late. TORRANTULA wide into the first turn, advanced outside, not good enough late. STAR FROM HEAVEN was hustled to command, set the early pace and weakened into the final furlong. LADY CLUE trailed early, never a threat. APPLIED ECONOMICS moved up the inside, tired into stretch. JIM'S GOLD chased off rail, failed to threaten. POT LUCK stalked early pacesetter, tired around far turn.
