Footnotes

DALT'S KINGPIN was checked repeatedly while boxed in behind STORMY FOREVER on the backstretch, took the second turn three wide, was altered out four wide for room leaving the eighth pole, closed fast and caught QUESTION (ARG) nearing the wire. QUESTION (ARG) advanced between horses, came five wide into the stretch, lugged in under a right whip near the eighth pole, took the lead shortly after that but was outfinished. FIN ENTERTAINMENT settled early, commenced his bid from outside after a half mile, lost considerable ground navigating the second turn five to six wide and found best stride too late. DON'T STRIKE OUT was kept close, went for the lead two wide on the second turn, dueled through the lane but wore down the last sixteenth. BULL MARKET vied for the early lead from outside, moved clear on the backstretch while in hand, was challenged from outside on the second turn, battled through the stretch but also wore down late. SHARM raced in contention early between rivals, took the second turn just off the rail, still had a striking position midstretch but gave way after that. STORMY FOREVER bobbled at the break, contested the pace from inside briefly but steadily faded once on the backstretch. BAYOU THE MOON an early factor between rivals, was blocked and steadied into the second turn, backed up four wide on that bend and had little left in the lane. OPINE pressed the early speed from outside but gave way five wide on the second turn.
