**Footnotes**

SALT N SEA was sent clear, took the inside into the bend then steadily widened under a drive in the lane. SOARING GODDESS in contention early from outside, improved position four wide on the turn and pulled clear for second late. SLEWFULS STAR pressed the pacesetter from inside, angled out some on the turn, proved no match for SALT N SEA in the lane and gradually wore down the last furlong. SWITCHIN LANES without early foot between horses, angled in leaving the turn, progressed to midstretch then finished evenly. HENNESSY'S LADY was prominent between rivals, angled outside REECE N OLIVIA nearing the bend, advanced four wide, angled in some leaving the turn and gradually wore down. ANDJUSTICEFORALL was also void of speed, checked along the rail when her path narrowed going to the quarter pole, altered out, came five wide into the stretch, advanced to the last furlong then leveled off. LAZY LUCI was a brief factor between horses but faded from inside on the turn. ROLLIN ROCKETS without speed between horses, was in path four entering the stretch and had no late bid. ROSY PROSPECT broke in the air, was soon taken inside and failed to menace. LONI MY LOVE soon trailed from outside, angled in to entering the lane from path three and had little to offer. REECE N OLIVIA forwardly placed between horses, was three and four wide taking the bend then gave way.
