Footnotes

COWBOY HENNESSY was clear before finishing the first sixteenth of a mile, challenged from outside nearing the turn, moved clear and stayed in path three on the bend, lengthened his lead upper stretch, was all out inside the final furlong, narrowly held on and was bumped by V. A. S. SIDEKICK at the wire. FAST A NUFF forwardly placed between horses, swung out into the turn, was six wide entering the stretch, rallied, gradually lugged in under a right whip the final sixteenth and also bumped. V. A. S. SIDEKICK was steadied as he jostled with BARBS LETTER shortly after the start, checked as he jostled again with the latter while in tight midway on the backstretch, was just off the inside on the turn, fanned four wide into the stretch, rallied the last eighth, was steadied as his path narrowed nearing the finish and checked as he was squeezed at the wire. JACK'S BAND showed first but was soon chasing the early speed from outside, backed up four wide on the bend, lost considerable ground fanning to the middle of the track for the stretch run, found best stride the last eighth and closed the gap. UNCLE JACK G inattentive just as the gate opened, left the gate several lengths behind most of the field, moved up quickly from outside, was four and five wide through the turn then lacked the extra needed for the drive. FOURTEEN KT. GOLD caught in crowding not long after the start, moved to the inside for a clear path midway on the backstretch, kept the rail through the bend then steadily made up ground in the lane. SHAZBOT broke in the air then bobbed on his landing, altered out for room midway on the backstretch, was just off the inside taking the turn, altered out some after entering the final furlong and was closing the gap late. GO EMMIT GO well placed inside through the early going, floated out some into the stretch and lacked a significant response. BARBS LETTER was away slowly, moved up in tight quarters between horses, jostled repeatedly with V. A. S. SIDEKICK through the first eighth, overcame that trouble to vie for the lead just outside COWBOY HENNESSY nearing the turn, could not stay with that one early in the turn, began to retreat between horses leaving the bend, swung out five wide for the drive and gave way. There was a stewards' inquiry into the race and an objection lodged by the rider of V. A. S. SIDEKICK alleging interference from FAST A NUFF nearing the wire. After their review, no action was taken.
