**Footnotes**

SWITHIN rated on the front end just off the inside, moved ahead and took the rail on the second turn, widened command upper stretch and held off JACKS LAST CHANCE under a drive. JACKS LAST CHANCE prominent between rivals from the beginning, commenced his bid three wide on the second turn, was all out in the stretch but came up short. GUY HUSTON rated from outside, picked up his pace just off the inside on the second turn, lost ground fanning five wide for the stretch run, found best stride too late but was clearly best of the rest. OLD CHARTER WHO vied for the lead just outside SWITHIN, could not stay with that one leaving the second turn and slowly yielded. GO BLAKERS GO gradually backed up from outside, was four wide taking the second bend and could only make up minor ground the last eighth. HARD ROAD made a small leap from the gate and bobbed on his landing, advanced between horses to reach contention on the backstretch, saved ground through the second turn but weakened for the drive. SQUAD LEADER chased from inside, swung out on the second turn, came six wide into the lane and lacked a rally. TIMPANI without early speed, was just off the inside on the second bend, fanned out some for the stretch run and had little to offer. SPIRIT MASTER soon trailed, was just off the inside entering the second turn, angled out widest upper stretch and had no late bid. AWESOME NINER hard sent, began to fade along the rail on the backstretch, floated out some for the stretch run and was empty.
