**Footnotes**

SOURIS rated early in the second flight, was angled three wide leaving the turn, weaved inside SANDIA'S FLICKA leaving the eighth pole, got the lead at the sixteenth marker then lugged in as she moved clear. SANDIA'S FLICKA broke in stride, set the pace in hand from outside, moved clear navigating the turn three to four wide, did not have enough left the final sixteenth but was clearly best of the rest. YET ANOTHERNATALIE displayed early speed between rivals, could not stay with SANDIA'S FLICKA on the turn, was angled in when SOURIS came close going to the sixteenth marker, altered out some after the winner was well clear and continued to weaken. LAUREN LYNN disputed the pace inside, gradually wore down leaving the turn and was also angled out for a clear path late. BENEFIT PARTY chased the early speed from between rivals, was angled in some entering the turn, came three wide into the lane and faded. MISS FRENCH raced in the second flight early from outside but gave way four wide on the turn. PROSPECTORS WEALTH chased the leaders from between horses, was checked back from tight quarters early in the turn and had nothing left.
