RODEO CAT soon had a clear lead, was challenged from outside on the turn, widened when asked leaving the bend and then continued to maintain control while ridden out under confident handling. HEISMAN U rated just off the inside, swung out to path three into the lane, commenced his bid, altered outside CHARLIE'S SONG midstretch and took over second late. CHARLIE'S SONG broke outward, bumping THE OLDE ONE, was corrected, ran in the second flight, went for the lead outside RODEO CAT on the turn, could not stay with the latter from path three in the lane and slowly wore down deep stretch. CHANDAS in midpack early between horses, was two to four wide taking the bend, drifted out some upper stretch, held a straight path the last eighth and was closing in for third. THE OLDE ONE made a small leap from the gate then was bumped, steadied, altered his path twice on the backstretch, two and three wide on the turn, altered in a for a clear path inside the final furlong and made up some ground. PRESIDENT PAUL was prominent from outside on the backstretch, angled in to the rail on the bend and flattened for the drive. TOOLATE AGAIN SAM was blocked and began to back up along the rail into the bend, floated out some entering the lane and steadily gave way.
