Footnotes

CLARA'S TIZZYCAT rated from inside, commenced his bid just off the inside on the bend, fanned out some into the stretch, was blocked behind SKAR, squeezed through two wide going to the sixteenth marker, was all out and edged ahead of VINCENT near the wire. VINCENT was kept close from inside, swung out four wide into the lane, gained the advantage, battled gamely but did not have the needed kick in the waning yards. HIGHLAND'S BEST was prominent toward the outside from the beginning, three to five wide taking the turn, could not close the gap the last eighth but got up for third. BILL'S DEMON raced in contention from outside, lost ground through the bend, bid with HIGHLAND'S BEST from just outside and narrowly missed third. SKAR contested the pace from outside, three wide on the turn and slowly wore down the last eighth. RADCLIFFE MAN vied for the lead between horses, moved ahead leaving the turn, gained the rail and also did not have enough left the final furlong. IRISH GLASS stumbled at the start, bumped with RETSINA SPRING, was taken outside, widest through the turn, made up ground to midstretch then finished evenly. RETSINA SPRING bumped with IRISH GLASS at the start, dueled for the lead from inside but gave way the last last quarter.
