TULIE CREEK CRYPT rated between horses, waited for room on the turn, got through three wide leaving the bend, took the lead upper stretch, moved clear inside the final furlong and held sway under a mild drive. MR. WIZARD was away slowly, chased from inside, came off the rail some on the turn, was three wide entering the lane, split rivals midstretch and again with a sixteenth to go as he made a strong move but was too late. DAVIDS KISS bumped solidly at the start, chased from between horses, advanced three wide on the turn, lost ground fanning out for a clear path leaving the bend, rallied belatedly seven wide and gained third. EROS EISHIN pressed from outside, was four wide on the turn, drifted out some entering the stretch and lacked the extra

needed. WYATT bumped hard with DAVIDS KISS at the break, quickly recovered to help prompt the pace from inside but slowly yielded the last quarter mile. COGBURN showed first, set a pressured pace between horses, was just off the inside taking the bend, could not stay with TULIE CREEK CRYPT upper stretch and gradually wore down the last furlong. FULL CUT was soon well back, swung out through the turn, came into the lane six wide, bumped with ZIP AND ZOOM upper stretch, altered outside EROS EISHIN with a furlong to go and was gaining ground late. ZIP AND ZOOM forwardly placed between horses, faded three wide on the turn, fanned to path five for the stretch run, bumped with FULL CAT soon after, altered in some, did not recover and finished on even terms with FLAGS JOURNEY. The latter displayed early speed between horses but began to tire four wide into the stretch. PINNING PUNCH chased from just off the inside, had the rail on the turn, came out a bit for the drive and had no late bid. PULPITS ATTITUDE soon moved to the outside, was widest taking the turn and had little to offer in the lane.
