HOCKEY FAN hesitated then made a small leap from the gate, quickly moved up inside, angled out some after entering the main track, three wide through the bend, gained a narrow lead just inside the eighth pole then held on under steady handling. MILTON'S CHOICE kept close inside, waited for room on the turn, got through along the rail into the stretch, bid for the lead but hung in the late going. COMIC LINE pinched then jostled out of the gate, was checked, settled inside, angled out on the turn, came six wide entering the lane, closed strongly but was too late. CAREER OF GOLD broke outward, jostled with COMIC LINE, moved up quickly to get the lead, was challenged from outside on the turn then slowly wore down two wide in deep stretch. NINER'S PULPIT washed out in the post parade, was also pinched and jostled between rivals shortly after the break, steadied, progressed between horses to have a striking position four wide through the bend but leveled off the final furlong. PRINCE CARSON bumped with SYDACIOUS at the start, displayed early speed from outside, went for the lead two wide on the turn, floated out to path three into the stretch and flattened. SYDACIOUS bumped with PRINCE CARSON at the break, was void of speed, advanced just off the inside on the turn, floated out some entering the lane, was blocked, altered out to path five nearing the eighth pole then lacked a late bid. OUR AVIATOR jostled with NINER'S PULPIT at the start, showed no speed between horses, angled in on the turn and had no stretch response. MT. SILVER in midpack early, gave way four wide on the bend.
