Footnotes

FOREST MOUSE forwardly placed between horses, was three wide taking the second turn, drew off under a drive in the stretch and established a new track record. TAP THE GOLD vied for the lead just outside WATCH ME GO, did not keep up leaving the second turn, was checked hard when cut off at the top of the stretch, altered out some, weaved through traffic and gained second. HURRICANE LAKE prominent from outside, was four wide taking the second bend, lacked a serious stretch bid but took over third late. GLOBAL STAGE in contention just off or along the rail, loomed a serious threat from inside midstretch but hung through the waning yards. OL WINEDRINKER WHO gradually backed up from between horses, lost ground four to six wide taking the second turn and found best stride too late in the lane. RED LEAD broke outward and was steadied, was settled inside, just off the rail through the second turn, altered outside for a clear path midstretch and was closing the gap on the second flight. WATCH ME GO broke alertly, showed the way from inside, began to tire leaving the second turn, drifted out some at the head of the lane and gradually yielded. HAPPY TOES chased from outside, was just off the rail taking the second bend and had no late bid. FOG ALERT soon trailed, took the rail on the second turn and was empty for the drive. There was a stewards' inquiry into TAP THE GOLD'S loss of action at the top of the stretch. The rider and trainer of TAP THE GOLD lodged objection alleging interference from FOREST MOUSE at the head of the lane. After their review, the stewards' determined it was WATCH ME GO that came out to cut off TAP THE GOLD at the top of the stretch and no action was taken.
