Footnotes

CITYMAN rated off the early speed from outside, gradually moved up on the backstretch to share the lead, took over from path two when asked on the second bend and was under a drive in the lane until the final sixteenth. GLENWOOD AUGGIE blocked behind the early speed while between rivals on the backstretch, swung out into the second turn, advanced four wide, angled in some leaving that bend, fought for second and secured it in the waning yards. RED HOT FAVORITE prominent from outside, advanced three wide on the second turn, was just off the inside entering the lane, battled for the place but did not have enough left nearing the wire. SLICKUNO broke slowly, was soon well back while unhurried, roused into the second bend, swung out leaving that turn and steadily advanced through the stretch. HEZA RARE BULL was steadied back from crowding shortly after the start, closed the gap from outside on the backstretch, improved position three wide on the second turn, altered out to path four for room just inside the furlong marker and finished evenly. SPEEDY DOMZALEZ advanced between horses to share the lead on the backstretch, gained the rail into the second turn, could not stay with CITYMAN, fought to keep second but slowly wore down in the lane. THEO raced in the second flight just off the inside to the second turn then began to tire. TRADERS TURN soon had a clear lead, was challenged from outside on the backstretch and gave way on the second bend.
