Footnotes

FAN'S CAT prominent from inside, was steadied while boxed in behind traffic into the turn and again at the three-furlong marker, altered out some, swung five wide leaving the turn, dueled for the lead the final sixteenth and narrowly prevailed. MERANDAS LEGEND progressed from outside, improved position while three and four wide taking the bend, battled between horses in deep stretch, missed but finished on even terms with FLYING Y L STORM. The latter shared the early lead between horses, moved ahead just off the inside leaving the turn, gradually drifted out in the lane, fought on even terms the last sixteenth but outfinished in a game effort. ELVIRA WHO boxed in behind the pacesetters from the early going, got through along the rail into the stretch, had every chance but could not close the gap the final eighth. PRAIRIE MOONLIGHT broke slowly and inward, was soon well back and well off the inside, angled in as she picked up her pace into the bend, swung out six wide for the stretch run, steadily made up ground and proved easily best of the rest. SUPER GOLLY contested the pace outside FLYING Y L STORM, could not stay with the latter leaving the turn and drifted out some as she tired between horses midstretch. WILD TIME TONIGHT raced in contention just off the inside on the backstretch, failed to stay close three wide on the turn and had little left for the drive. HENNESSY'S LADY displayed early speed inside but gave way on the bend.
