Footnotes

SKIP AND GO moved up between horses to vie for the lead on the backstretch, took over two wide leaving the second turn, was driven clear in the lane and held off TWO DOWN AUTOMATIC under a stern left whip. TWO DOWN AUTOMATIC pressed the pace from outside, was three to four wide through the second turn, had every chance through the stretch, hung but was clearly second best. BEYOND BRILLIANT sprinted clear, was challenged from outside going to the halfway point, dueled inside through the second turn, began to tire in the lane and drifted out late. FIN ENTERTAINMENT far back early, picked up his pace going to the second turn, saved ground through that bend, was angled out three wide for room in the upper stretch and passed tired ones from inside. STONE CANYON was checked back from crowding into the first turn, moved up to contention four wide on the backstretch, advanced through the second turn, carried five wide into the stretch, lacked a bid and gradually lugged in late. INDIAN EXPRESS raced in the second flight outside, took the second turn three to four wide, weakened in the lane and also lugged in. THUNDER SQUALL void of speed outside, was angled in entering the stretch, moved outside LONG RANGE inside the final furlong, passed that one at the wire but had to be vanned off after the race. LONG RANGE was checked off of heels into the first turn, boxed in behind the leaders on the backstretch, gave way three wide on the second turn, moved to the rail and continued to fade. PROPER PROSPECT was an early factor inside, gave way early in the second turn, was swung outside leaving that bend and had little left.
