Footnotes

GONE TILL MIDNIGHT was settled back just off the inside after the break, picked up his pace on the turn, swung out to path three for the stretch run, rallied under a drive and shook off DOME ALASKA the final sixteenth. DOME ALASKA showed first, vied for the lead from outside, two wide on the turn, floated out to path four entering the lane, tried hard but slowly wore down the last sixteenth. TY'S BAND was kept close, stayed just outside DOME ALASKA as he closed the gap taking the bend, moved clear for third upper stretch, lacked the needed late bid but proved clearly best of the others. DUDE ON THE LOOSE progressed from outside to have a striking position four wide on the turn, drifted out to the middle of the track entering the stretch and could not close the gap. FIRE E BEAN without speed between rivals, angled in nearing the bend, swung out to path three for the drive then gradually improved position without threatening. WILD SWEEP was moved outside midway on the backstretch, four to six wide taking the turn then failed to have a significant stretch bid. PERFECT X PLAY was soon taken inside, steadied behind traffic with a quarter mile left, altered inside leaving the turn and steadily advanced from just off

the rail. WEST OF TEXAS in midpack early between horses, faded three wide on the turn. QUEENAHEARTACHES void of speed from outside, was in paths four or five taking the bend and lacked a stretch rally. A SURPRISE BULL advanced from inside after a poor break, swung out to path three into the lane and had no late bid. RAISINGAPROSPECTOR showed little from between horses. FIRST TOUCHDOWN dueled for the lead from inside but faltered in the lane.
