EAT DESSERT FIRST steadied when crowded by R AND B STAR shortly after the break, waited for room behind the early speed, progressed just off the inside on the second bend, swung outside R AND B STAR, leaving that turn, had the advantage into the, quickly drew clear, was trying to drift out deep stretch and put to mild right-hand pressure. ELAINE CAN DU reared up at the start and left the gate well behind the rest, advanced from outside on the backstretch, was boxed in between horses and waited for room on the second turn, got through four wide at the top of the stretch, could only make up minor ground on the winner the final furlong but pulled away from the rest for second. K O OKAY dwelt at the break, was settled between rivals, commenced her bid nearing the second turn, gained a striking position just off the inside shortly after that, came three wide into the stretch, angled out some upper stretch, lacked a significant bid but got up for third late. CRUSADEN rated from inside, made her bid along the rail on the second bend, came off the inside some entering the lane, altered inside nearing the final sixteenth, had third late but was outfinished. R AND B STAR broke alertly and drifted out briefly, vied for the lead inside her rivals but just off the inside, moved ahead on the second bend, could not stay with EAT DESSERT FIRST into the stretch, floated out behind that one, began to wear down the last furlong and lugged in nearing the sixteenth marker. SHESA GLIDER void of speed from inside, picked up her pace just off the rail on the second turn, gradually altered out to path five upper stretch and improved her position without threatening. I'M A WINDTALKER contested the pace between horses, began to back up three wide on the second turn, drifted out to path six leaving that bend and continued to fade. PREMEDITATEDAFFAIR five wide into the first turn, dueled for the lead outside I'M A WINDTALKER, also tired leaving the second bend, drifted out to the middle of the track entering the stretch and steadily gave way. FERNSPIRITEDMILLER also lost ground following PREMEDITATEDAFFAIR on the first turn,

pressed the leaders from outside on the backstretch, faded five wide on the second turn, was angled in upper stretch and continued to retreat. There was an inquiry into ELAINE CAN DU'S start but it was determined she was prepared for the break and no action was taken.
