Footnotes

RUFFY TRICK broke inward, shared the lead from just off the inside, took the rail on the turn, moved clear upper stretch then maintained control under a late whip. REINA DE CIELO prominent between horses from the beginning, was three and four wide taking the bend, brushed with KARENS PRIZE into lane, battled that one for second through the stretch and prevailed for the place. KARENS PRIZE pressed the pacesetters while toward the outside, stayed just outside REINA DE CIELO through the turn, crowded some entering the stretch, fought for the place but did not have enough late. SAINT STREET stumbled at the break and bumped with ROYAL JAMIE, advanced along the rail, was boxed in and waited for room through the turn and most of the stretch, gained a clear path two wide with a sixteenth left but lacked the needed bid. READUM N REAP gradually backed up from between horses going to the turn, came four wide into the stretch, lodged her bid, was blocked inside the last furlong, altered out after entering the final sixteenth then continued to improve her position. MY EMERALD contested the pace outside RUFFY TRICK, floated out a bit entering the stretch, quickly angled back in but drifted out to path three as she wore down inside the last furlong. PLUM FAST was an early factor between horses, advanced inside on the bend but had no late bid. YOUR WILD EMINENCE raced in contention along or just off the rail, swung out five wide on the turn then flattened out for the drive. RECKLESS PATCH away a step slowly, was then steadied behind traffic, altered in, in paths two or three taking the turn and lacked a stretch rally. FANCY FREEZE was also away a step slowly, altered out for a clear path, soon well back, took the bend just off the inside, had little to offer in the stretch and was altered outside when TAKE

THE TOP crossed her path in the waning yards. ROYAL JAMIE bumped with SAINT STREET at the break then showed little in a ground-saving trip. TAKE THE TOP displayed early speed from outside but faded on the turn and lugged in as she continued to give way.
