**Footnotes**

YOUR MY IRISH PAL rated on the front end between horses, moved clear two wide leaving the bend, opened up in the stretch, was ridden out inside the last eighth and allowed to coast through the waning yards. SECONDCHANCEROLL bumped at the start, raced in contention just off the inside on the backstretch, did not keep up while along the rail on the turn, came off the inside some for the stretch run, angled out a bit further near the eighth, took over second inside the last furlong and could only hold his position late. THREEGOODKIDS forwardly placed from the beginning, was just off the inside on the bend, fanned out to path three entering the lane, was forced out some midstretch and finished evenly. KEY TO THE BAND in tight between rivals while blocked behind the early leaders, advanced inside on the turn, swung out leaving the bend, came four wide into the stretch, came out some to keep clear of THREEGOODKIDS with a furlong to go and improved position. LESS ODDS broke outward, bumping SECONDCHANCEROLL, was without early speed from inside, came off the rail some on the turn, lost considerable ground as he swung out leaving the turn, floated to path seven into the stretch then steadily

advanced without threatening. BEER THIRTY TIME soon trailed, was three wide on the turn, angled in leaving the bend, progressed to midstretch, came off the rail some nearing the sixteenth marker and finished evenly. CHIEF LAZ chased from between horses, was three then four wide taking the bend and had no late bid. GET UP TAYLOR away a step slowly, advanced between horses, began to fade four wide on the turn, swung out toward the middle of the track entering the lane, was forced out some by LESS ODDS at the top of the stretch and had little to offer. STASH THE TRASH disputed the pace just off the inside, took the rail into the turn, his rider lost his whip midway on the bend, could not stay with YOUR MY IRISH PAL leaving the turn and flattened out the last furlong. HONOR EXPRESS displayed early speed from outside, could not keep up three wide on the turn, began to float out leaving the bend and steadily faded the last three-sixteenths. HIGH SIETE steadily backed up while toward the outside, was widest taking the turn and empty through the lane.
