Footnotes

WESTERN WAY waited behind the pacesetters, got through three wide midway on the bend, floated out some as she gained the advantage upper stretch then gradually moved clear under mild urging the last furlong. KISS TIN trailed from outside, angled in entering the bend, was blocked, squeezed through two wide between horses leaving the quarter pole, fanned out some for the stretch run and moved clear for the place the last seventy yards. SILK STRAWBERRY bumped at the start, raced in contention between horses, was four wide into the bend, steadied behind traffic leaving the quarter pole, altered in for a clear path upper stretch, weaved through traffic the last furlong and got up for third nearing the wire. MISS DESERT FREEZE disputed the pace between horses, was just off the inside through the bend then gradually wore down inside the last furlong. GO DOM GO fractious in the post parade, dueled for the lead just inside MISS DESERT BREEZE, had the rail through the bend and also did not have enough left inside the final eighth. ROAD TIME bumped with SILK STRAWBERRY at the break, raced in contention toward the outside, lost ground widest through the turn and lacked a stretch bid. NEW GOLD brushed at the start, pressed the early speed from outside, failed to keep up between rivals on the turn, was forced out some leaving the bend, flattened and lugged in late. SO LONG SASACYA moved up from inside to help prompt the pace, had the rail through the turn, was caught in crowding briefly leaving the bend and steadily gave way through the lane.
