Footnotes

FLASHY RED ODD'S broke alertly, was rated on the front end from outside, floated out to path three for the stretch run, steadily drew off and was kept to urging until nearing the wire. PRECOCIOUS DERBY a bit slow at the break, was checked behind traffic just after the start, progressed between rivals, four then five wide through the turn, closed well the last eighth and caught SETS SHADOW for second. SETS SHADOW disputed the pace just off the inside, gained the rail on the turn, was no match for FLASHY RED ODD'S when set down for the drive and began to wear down the final sixteenth. MR. SCARFACE prominent between rivals, had the rail into the bend, swung out four wide entering the lane and lacked the extra needed kick. TRUE TO CHOPIN broke inward and was checked, moved up quickly between horses, lost position while three wide through the bend, angled in some upper stretch then weaved out and back in deep stretch. SILVER NITE R F a contender between horses on the backstretch, began to tire just off the inside taking the turn. FIRE E BEAN chased from between horses, was three and four wide through the turn, his rider lost his whip upper stretch and he finished evenly. LEE'S BREEZE void of speed, was just off the inside on the turn, fanned out some for the drive, gradually angled out further midstretch and had no late bid. BOLD ENTITY a step slow at the break, trailed from inside, was just off the rail for the stretch run and had little to offer. DISTORTED DANCER was a factor from outside on the backstretch but gave way widest on the turn. CHASING OUR DREAMS displayed early speed between horses, began to back up just off the inside into the turn, was taken up with three furlongs to go, pulled up shortly after that and vanned off.
