**Footnotes**

EMPIRE HOUSE was forwardly placed angling in three wide to save some ground, placed a bid nearing the eighth pole and kicked clear. SHOWTIME DON was off slow early, closed the gap into the turn six wide and finished well to get up for the place. LAST MINUTE JOE was void of early speed, advanced steadily to the top of the stretch, altered inward to split foes and closed in the late going. MUTE BUTTON set the early pace, was challenged nearing the quarter pole and flattened in the drive. RAISED WESTERN was off slow early, gained ground five wide, altered in between foes and showed some effort late. GILDED PROMISE raced wide mid pack and lacked a rally. MIGHTYAMERICAN was forwardly placed early, made a bid mid way then weakened. SECRET K. O. was outrun early saving ground and lacked a late response. WEST TEXAS EXPRESS faded steadily four wide. DARN THAT CRUISER forced the early pace, was used up early and stopped. HAP HAP was unhurried early and broke down near the three eighths pole. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
