**Footnotes**

TYGER TERAS was unhurried early racing five wide, gained ground in the second turn, drifted in three wide at the three sixteenths then kicked clear in deep stretch. BACK SEAT ROLL was allowed to settle early, went five wide to rally in the stretch, closed willingly and was up for the place. LAKEHOUSE FUN was never far back early, sustained a bid three wide and gained the show. K B 'S PRINCESS stalked the early leaders, then loomed up to draw clear in the turn, was challenged nearing the eighth pole then weakened in the drive. DESERTSMAGIC was void of early speed, went three wide and showed some effort late. PARK LANE LASS was forwardly placed four wide then gave way. DANDY DEVONA R F was outrun and lacked a late response. WAY TO GO GERDA prompted the early pace while saving ground then faded steadily. MARTHAS PRINCESS was close early, went four wide and retreated. CHICKEE CHICKEE showed early speed drawing clear and was used up. STORM DANCING broke poor, raced wide and was not a factor.
