FANNY CHENAL prompted the early pace four wide, placed a bid nearing the sixteenth pole and surged clear in deep stretch. SMART CITY DOC set the early pace racing off the rail, edged a clear advantage at the eighth pole, was challenged nearing the sixteenth and failed to match strides. SHE'S OUTTA THERE was unhurried early, rallied in the stretch four wide, closed late and was up for the show. LAST WAGER tracked the early leaders along the inside, sustained a brief bid mid way then yielded. SONGTRESS dropped back early racing off the inside and passed tiring foes in the stretch. PERFECT FINISH was unhurried early, went four wide and lacked a late effort. SLIVEN was off slow early, moved up between foes, drifted out in the stretch and gave way.
