**Footnotes**

ENAMORADO raced mid pack, went five wide into the turn, loomed up nearing the quarter pole to gain the lead, was challenged in deep stretch, battled back to kick clear and prevail. CAPE SABLE forced the early pace three wide, sustained a bid to gain a short lead, was overtaken into the stretch by ENAMORADO, fought back but was no match late. AWESOME AUSSIE was unhurried early, rallied nearing the quarter pole splitting foes and showed some effort late. BEAU'S HALO broke sharply then dropped back down the backstretch and placed a steady effort through the stretch. T DRIVE was unhurried early saving ground and placed a mild bid along the rail. SAILOR'S HALO was outrun early, went eight wide and placed a mild effort. BURBANK TOO was forwardly placed early, went six wide near the quarter pole then weakened. U F O DETECTED showed some brief speed off the inside and was finished early. UNBRIDLED EGO pressed the early pace from along the inside and was finished after a half. EVENTFUL CONQUEST was void of early speed racing off the rail and was not a factor. The rider of UNBRIDLED EGO claimed interference against the rider of CAPE SABLE and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
