Footnotes

CHABELITA settled at the back and inside, split rivals into the second turn, was steadied as she waited for room three wide leaving the quarter pole, got through four wide at the top of the stretch, soon gained the lead then steadily opened up while ridden out in the late going. MYROSAPOZZI was quickly clear, showed the way from inside, was challenged leaving the second bend, floated out some into the lane, fought to keep second the final furlong and shook off MIMI'S REWARD late. MIMI'S REWARD in the second flight from inside, angled out some and went for the lead on the second turn, stayed outside MYROSAPOZZI into the stretch, battled for the place the last eighth, began to yield in the waning yards but was clearly best of the rest. RUN JENNIE RUN chased the pacesetter while toward the outside, closed the gap three wide on the second turn, swung out to path five for the stretch run and slowly wore down. RANANDI was boxed in between horses from the early going, waited for room on the second turn, gained a clear path along the rail at the head of the lane but had no late bid. FEELIN FREE broke a step slow and outward, was steadied, advanced to contention from outside on the backstretch, four wide through the second bend, altered in for a clear path upper stretch but had little to offer. ICING was hustled along between rivals, checked when her path narrowed near the half mile marker and steadily gave way. APRIL SPOOLS very fractious in the gate before the break, showed first, was an early factor just off the inside but faded into the second turn.
