Footnotes

EL BATALLON rated just off the pace from inside, came two wide into the lane, battled for the lead, gained the advantage at the sixteenth pole and held on under steady handling. MOTION APPROVED boxed in early behind the pacesetters, swung out five wide into the stretch, vied for the lead from outside but did not have enough late. DEVIOUS CHOICE forced out after the start, contested the early pace outside ISLANDS SUCESS, in path four entering the stretch, tried hard but wore down between horses the last sixteenth. EXCESSIVE CONTACT angled in early on, advanced three wide on the second turn, rallied just off the rail through the upper stretch but could not sustain his bid late. ISLANDS SUCESS drifted out after the start, moved up between horses to vie for the lead, gained the inside on the second turn then flattened out for the drive. WILLIONAIRE settled early, advanced between horses on the second turn, fanned six wide into the stretch then passed tired ones. TAKIN ISSUE progressed from outside on the backstretch, four wide leaving the second turn and lacked a stretch bid. SECRET FOLLY backed up from between rivals going to the half mile pole, swung seven wide into the lane and had little left through the stretch. LIZARD KING broke a bit awkwardly, trailed most of the way, saved ground through the second turn and had no late bid. KING FO' REEL raced in the second flight on the backstretch but gave way four wide after five furlongs.
