JARETT'S CAT was hustled away to set the early pace, edged clear and held well in the stretch. QUINTON'S FIRST chased the early leader, rallied in deep stretch three wide, showed some effort late and was gaining. EL PROSPECTO was close in the early going, went between foes at the quarter pole, vied in the stretch showing some late interest to gain the show. ON FIFTH STREET was unhurried early racing off the rail and placed a steady effort late. POPASHORE broke slowly at the break, was outrun in the early stages, then showed a steady gain late. MISTER TUTU was forwardly placed early racing off the rail then weakened. PERFECT X PLAY was off slow early, went six wide at the quarter pole and placed a mild bid. NITRO BUD was void of early speed, placed a brief bid seven wide nearing the quarter pole then flattened. GONE PACK N broke sharply at the break, then settled into stride racing five wide and gave way in the stretch. FOREVER ROLLING made a move mid way then faded. PUNXSUTAWNEY SIX was steadied into the turn then dropped back and was not a factor.
