Footnotes

MAX BEAN rated off the early speed, closed the gap just outside the leader on the backstretch, took over two wide on the second turn, moved clear upper stretch, responded to a few taps of the whip, continued to open up and proved much the best ridden out. CATCH THE BEAN drifted out entering the backstretch, gradually progressed toward the outside, was just off the rail into the second bend, fanned out some leaving that turn, drifted out further entering the stretch, took over second approaching the last sixteenth and steadily moved clear for that position. RED HOT FAVORITE broke alertly, was quickly clear, showed the way just off the inside, challenged nearing the second turn, took the rail on that bend, could not stay with MAX BEAN when set down for the drive and wore down the final furlong. STARLIGHT MESA void of speed from inside, gradually made up ground on the second turn, fanned out some for the drive and lacked a significant bid between horses. LANE STORMER unruly in the gate, lost ground staying outside CATCH THE BEAN through both turns and tired in the lane. ONE FINE JEWEL soon trailed, was just off the inside on the second bend, came into the lane from path four and was unresponsive.
