INVASIVE COCKTAIL raced mid pack, rallied seven wide into the stretch, wore down his foes through the stretch and was up at the wire. TAKE A KNEE stalked the early leaders four wide, sustained a bid to gain the lead, drew clear in the stretch but was outfinished by closed rival. TURNING TABLES was unhurried early, vied five wide to be within striking distance then went evenly late to hold the show. CLONE was off slow early to be well back early, began to close the gap into the turn, circled the field eight wide and closed well while drifting in some through the stretch. JUSTICA was allowed to settle early, swung out six wide and placed a mild bid. WALDO lacked early speed, went four wide near the three sixteenths, angled in some through the stretch and placed a mild effort. BRENDA'S BAR was void of early speed along the inside and passed tiring foes. FRANK N JOHNNY set the early pace saving ground, was finished early and faded. ROCKY'S HIGH forced the early pace from between foes then tired and gave way. IN REAL TIME was forwardly placed early six wide then retreated.
