Footnotes

JAMMIN GEARS shared the early lead from outside, two wide on the second turn, drew clear when asked in the stretch, put to a late left whip and held off REAL COOL JAZZ. The latter, settled not far off the inside, swung out into the second turn, commenced his bid, came four wide into the lane, steadily closed the gap, lugged in with a sixteenth left, was corrected, getting to the winner late and clearly second best. HIGH PITCH set a pressured pace inside then wore down for the drive. GREAT DEFEAT trailed from inside, also made his move into the second turn, advanced between rivals, was blocked briefly leaving that bend, steadied, split rivals two wide in tight quarters nearing the final furlong then progressed and narrowly missed third. TAG THE COMET steadily progressed between rivals to have a striking position three wide on the second turn but weakened for the drive. SHOOTER'S TOUCH prompted the pace from inside, was boxed in and steadied midway on the backstretch, had a clear path just off the rail into the stretch but gave way. SWISS RESERVE four to five wide throughout, was finished after five furlongs. DR. DEPUTY washed out in the post parade, was crowded briefly at the start, quickly moved up between rivals to race in contention but gave way four wide on the second turn. CONCEPTUAL came off the rail early on, was an early factor between horses, quit three wide early in the second turn, eased through the lane and walked off.
