**Footnotes**

CATTLEMAN PROSPECT rated from inside on the backstretch, picked up his pace along the rail into the turn, swung out leaving the quarter pole, was five wide into the lane, altered outside JACK'S BAND upper stretch, rallied under a drive, gained the advantage with seventy yards left and narrowly held on. CATABOLIZE hustled along between horses early, was three wide entering the turn, lost ground fanning to path seven entering the stretch, was all out, slowly closed the gap, took over second with seventy yards left and just missed for the win. H. E.'S FAST was soon well back and well off the inside, also in path three into the bend, lost the most ground by fanning widest entering the stretch, rallied strongly but was too late. JACK'S BAND gradually angled out trying to gain clear path on the backstretch, improved position four wide on the turn, dueled for the lead between horses in the stretch but did not have enough left inside the final sixteenth. IRISH GLASS showed first, contested the pace from outside, angled in beside CHACO LATTE into the bend, floated out to path three at the top of the lane, tried hard but also weakened deep stretch. EL DRAMO prominent between horses on the backstretch, altered outside IRISH GLASS into the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, dueled for the lead but also wore down the last sixteenth. BLUSHING FINA well placed from inside, waited for room just off the rail with a quarter mile to go, altered in some upper stretch, squeezed through two wide, threatened with a furlong left but hung in the late going. CHACO LATTE vied for the lead from inside, began to tire upper stretch and flattened the last eighth.
