Footnotes

SUSPENDTHEBORDERS showed first, was rated between horses, roused four wide leaving the turn, battled on even terms inside the final sixteenth and edged out NUGGET CANDY. NUGGET CANDY jostled briefly with LOGAN'S FLAG shortly after the break, was caught in tight quarters midway on the backstretch, steadied approaching the half mile marker, altered in some near the bend, swung out again just after entering the turn, came three wide into the stretch, rallied between rivals, had a slight advantage with seventy yards to go but was outfinished in a game effort. JAMIES VALENTINO gradually angled in as he disputed the pace, was two wide through the bend, moved ahead upper stretch, could not shake free, slowly yielded the last seventy yards but was clearly best of the rest. LOGAN'S FLAG jostled with NUGGET CANDY after the start, was steadied, quickly recovered, advanced between horses to vie for the lead, gained the rail into the turn then gradually wore down the last furlong. TITANIUM HALO an early contender from outside, failed to keep up five wide leaving the turn and ran evenly through the lane. NICKI'S WINSTON inattentive in the gate, was away slowly, forced to alter out to stay clear of UNA MAS BOSS soon after the break, gradually angled in through the bend, advanced three wide upper stretch then leveled off. SILVER DEVIL R F caught in crowding and steadied approaching the half mile pole, swung out widest through the turn, came into the lane from the middle of the track and had no late bid. EMINENT CLASS a step slow at the start, was soon well back while widest, moved to the rail into the turn and a couple tired ones from inside upper

stretch. UNA MAS BOSS dwelt at the break, veered out abruptly shortly after leaving the gate to avoid the jostling NUGGET CANDY and LOGAN'S FLAG, backed up four wide leaving the bend and had little to offer in the stretch. BOOMER ZOOMER checked solidly when caught in crowding after travelling the first sixteenth of a mile, was kept along the rail and in hand until nearing the turn, floated out to path three on the bend and was empty for the drive.
